Linking Up to Save Lives

Two pioneering companies join forces to make Air Ambulance emergency care faster, more accessible

(Changi, SINGAPORE) – Anywhere, anytime capability. In handling medical emergencies, where each precious minute and every single mile become the crucial variables for survival, speed and coverage are non-negotiable.
